AEPC invites separate application for export awards for the financial year 2021-22 & 2022-23 from Council's member/registered exporters to recognize their meritorious performance in **13** different categories.

1. Key dates:

- Last date of receipt of Applications: 23rd October, 2023 (Monday).
- Award Function: 8th December, 2023
- 2. The details of the Categories of Export Awards and the eligibility in addition to generic eligibility, are given at **Annexure-I**.
- 3. The general eligibility criteria and terms and conditions are given at Annexure-II.
- 4. The format of Chartered Accountant Certificate is given at Annexure-III.
- 5. The format for a brief profile of the Chairman or CEO or Managing Director who shall be receiving the award is given at **Annexure-IV**.
- 6. The awards are for the aggregate of the two years (2021-22 & 2022-23)
- 7. One company will get one award only.
- 8. Award will only be given if a suitable number of applications are received.

You are requested to kindly go through the circular completely before submitting the application.

Applications complete in all respect, should reach us on or before 23rd October, 2023 (Monday). For nominations, please click http://aepcindia.com/aepc-export-award-2023. The decision of an independent Jury shall be final and no correspondence in this respect shall be entertained. It would be mandatory for the applicant to come in person to receive the award.

The Council reserves the right to reject or not to entertain any application.

The eligibility criteria and terms/ conditions for grant of awards for the year 2021-22 & 2022-23 applicable across all categories are given below:-

- a) The base period for considering the awards would be the export performance during the FY 2021-22 & 2022-23. The award is open to those who are member of the Council under the Export Import Policy of the Government of India. The applicant must have paid AEPC subscription for the year 2021-22, 2022-23 & 2023-24.
- b) Applications for grant of Export Awards will be considered subject to the condition that nothing adverse about the business dealing of the applicants has come to the notice of the Council and/or other authorities.
- c) Items of exports for grant of Export Awards include all type of readymade garments (RMGs) falling in HS Code 61 & 62.
- d) Export Performance should include only those exports which have been reflected in the name of the applicant/Company.
- e) Export Performance should include the value of only those manufactured products which are exported from Indian Soil. The chartered Accountant's Certificate should clearly specify this.
- f) For grant of award in each category there should be minimum 3 applications.
- g) No application for Export Awards would be considered if the application forms are not properly filled-in and incomplete applications are liable to be rejected. Applications received after the due date is also liable to be rejected.
- h) Each application will be considered for the award in the Categories under the scheme and hence complete details should be given and each column of the application should be filled up.
- i) The export figures are to be given by the exporters in terms of FOB value of exports on the actual exports affected during the financial year 2021-22 & 2022-23. **Only direct exports will be taken into account for the purpose of selection of export awards**.
- j) FOB value of exports should be value of exports excluding commission paid/payable to overseas agents/importers only should be shown. The exporters will have to produce a Chartered Accountant's Certificate certifying that the figures provided by the applicants were verified and found to be corrected by them.
- k) AEPC will be checking all applicants details from RCMC & Vigilance Department & shall confirm that:
 - i. The payment has been duly received.
 - ii. There is no vigilance case against the applicant.
 - iii. The export performance mentioned includes 'Direct Exports' only.

All applications for Export Awards must be received latest by **23**rd **October**, **2023 (Monday)**. Please click http://aepcindia.com/aepc-export-award-2023 to file the application form.

Applications received thereafter may not be considered for award.
