## Sub: Extension of Foreign Trade Policy, (2015-20) and Handbook of Procedures, (2015-20) upto 31.03.2023

- 1. Kindly refer to AEPC Circular No 85 dated 31.03.2022 informing therein extension of Foreign Trade Policy 2015-2020 and Hand Book of Procedures, 2015-2020 till 30.09.2022 vide Directorate General of Foreign Trade Notification No. 64/2015-20 & Public Notice No 53/2015-20 both dated 31.03.2022 respectively.
- 2. The Government of India, Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Department of Commerce, DGFT, New Delhi vide Notification No. 37/2015-20 (enclosed) dated 29.09.2022 has informed that the **Foreign Trade Policy (FTP), 2015-2020** which is valid upto 30.09.2022 is further extended **upto 31.03.2023.**
- The Government of India, Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Department of Commerce, DGFT, New Delhi vide Public Notice No. 26/2015-20 (enclosed) dated 29.09.2022 has informed that the **HandBook of Procedures (HBP), 2015-2020** which is valid upto 30.09.2022 is further extended **upto 31.03.2023**.
