Subject: Extension in date of filing of application under the Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme for Textiles

This is in reference to AEPC Circular No. 56 dated 30/12/2021 sharing therewith the operational guidelines (along with its highlights) of PLI scheme released by the Ministry of Textiles on 28th Dec 2021 (Click here for the guidelines).

- 2. As per the said operational guidelines, the time schedule for Application i.e. Application window for registration under the Scheme, was opened for the period 1st January, 2022 to 31st January, 2022 on on-line portal. No application was acceptable after the closure of the application window.
- 3. Now, the <u>timelines for submission of applications under the PLI Scheme for Textiles has</u> <u>been extended till 14/02/2022</u> vide Ministry of Textiles' Notice File No. 12015/03/2020-IT dated 27/01/2022 (copy enclosed).
- 4. This is the first of its kind scheme with the financial incentive upto 15% for Scheme-1, for minimum investment of Rs.300 crore and 11% for Scheme-2, for minimum investment of Rs.100 crore. The scheme is aligned to the Made in India vision of the Government and is a flagship scheme to enhance India's overall manufacturing capabilities, generating employment and benchmarking them to global standards. We urge the Members to avail of this opportunity and apply for the scheme, within the timelines.
- 5. The eligible applicants may apply through on-line portal. The link is https://pli.texmin.gov.in/mainapp/Default.
