## Sub: Mandatory filing / issuance of Registration Cum Membership Certificate (RCMC) / Registration Certificate (RC) through the DGFT common digital platform from 01.04.2022

This is with reference to Trade Notice No. 27 dated 30.11.2021 (<u>click here to view</u>) issued by DGFT regarding electronic filing of Registration cum Membership Certificate (RCMC) / Registration Certificate through the common digital platform of DGFT.

2. With reference to the above said Trade Notice, DGFT has issued a Trade Notice No. 35/2021-2022 (<u>click here to view</u>) informing that the electronic platform to facilitate electronic issuance/renewal/amendment of Registration Cum Membership Certificate (RCMC)/ Registration Certificate (RC) has been implemented with the objective to provide an electronic, contact-less single window for RCMC/RC related processes.

3. In this context, <u>it is informed that from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2022, it will be mandatory for the</u> <u>exporters to file Registration Cum Membership Certificate (RCMC)/ Registration Certificate</u> (RC) applications (for issue/renewal/amendment) through the common digital portal of e-<u>RCMC Pla</u>tform.

4. <u>As registering authority, AEPC is already on-boarded</u> and will adopt the e-RCMC platform of DGFT as a single point for handling RCMC related processes from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2022. The prevailing procedure of submitting applications directly to AEPC will continue only till 31.03.2022.
