AEPC's participation in Tex World Apparel Sourcing Paris, France

AEPC participated in the Tex World Apparel Sourcing Paris, France with 32 prominent exhibitors. Mr. Jawed Ashraf, Ambassador of India to France inaugurated the Indian pavilion at Texworld, Paris, on 1st July, 2024.

AEPC Chairman participated in the press conference and briefed about India's efforts on sustainability, especially in wind & solar power, water conservation, water recycling, use of recycled fibers, etc.

Chairman also spoke about the upcoming Textile event - India Bharat Tex 2025 and various initiatives launched by the Government of India for promoting Apparel and Textile sector.

AEPC requests to resolve anomaly in the MSME portal

AEPC vide its letter dated 2nd July 2024 to the Joint Development Commissioner (Policy), Office of DC-MSME has addressed an Issue with MSME Portal Classification that our member exporters have brought to our notice.

Currently, the information with regard to investment in the plant & machinery is picked up in this portal from the Income-tax Return filed by the manufacturing entity. There is no provision in the Income-tax return to separately indicate the cost of pollution control equipments, research & development equipments and other such equipments, which are excluded from the purview of calculation for the purpose of determining investment in the plant & machinery for categorization under MSME. Consequently, the entire investment in the plant & machinery, including those in the excluded category of plant & machinery indicated under Notification No.S.O.1722(E) dated 5th October, 2006, gets captured in the portal. This results in borderline MSME cases getting tossed out of MSME category.

Most of our members invest in pollution control equipments, research and development equipments and industrial safety devices to make apparel industry more sustainable and some of them are facing the issue specified above.

This anomaly in the MSME portal has resulted in a number of our members getting removed from the MSME category and being treated as non-MSME despite being eligible.

AEPC's participation in the Sourcing at Magic, Las Vegas, USA

To enhance trade between India and US, AEPC is going to participate in the Sourcing at Magic, Las Vegas, USA from 19th to 21st August, 2024 with Indian apparel exhibitors across the country under the Market Access Initiative of the Ministry of Commerce, Govt. of India.

AEPC has circulated the details to the member exporters of the trade and industry on 8.4.2024.

He further announced that AEPC will continue its series of seminars and webinars, inviting everyone to join and benefit from them.
