Subject: Launch of Textile Registration and Services (TSRS) Portal – Migration of Legacy Data and One-Time Profile Update Facility for Units and Status of New Registration Process – Reg.

The Office of the Textile Commissioner, Ministry of Textiles, Government of India, has informed about the launch of the Textile Registration and Services (TSRS) Portal. The revamped portal has been introduced to strengthen textile statistics and facilitate registration and submission of information by textile units.

The key features and instructions regarding the TSRS Portal are detailed in Circular No. 28(1)2022/TSRS/E&SBr/4 dated 18.09.2026, issued by the Ministry of Textiles, is enclosed for your information and necessary action.

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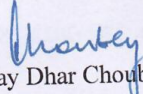
Subject: Launch of the Textile Registration and Services (TSRS) portal, migration of legacy TSRS data, one-time profile update facility for units, and status of new registration process — reg.

All Associations/Federations/Corporations/EPCs and units concerned are hereby informed as under, for information, wide circulation among their members, and necessary action.

2. As you may be aware, the TSRS portal has been launched by the Hon'ble Minister of Textiles on 22.08.2026. This will help in strengthening the textile statistics for the textile value chain.
3. The revamped portal has been launched with several new features, including login with mobile number, OTP-verified returns, a Chatbot to resolve problems on the spot, a Raise Your Query option, and the facility to register multiple units under a single PAN in a single login.
4. The data of the old TSRS portal has also been migrated to the new portal. Units that were already registered can log in using the TUID (Textile Unit ID) already allotted to them.
5. Further, upon logging in with the existing TUID, a one-time chance of profile update has been provided to the units that are registered on the old TSRS portal. Under this facility, units are able to add more than one unit under their profile by entering the GST details pertaining to their establishments in different States, thereby enabling consolidated management of multiple units through a single login.
6. As regards new registrations, in the current portal a unit may register itself using its PAN and GST details, PAN and GST being the primary identifiers for the unit.
7. **It is specifically brought to the notice of all concerned that, in respect of units that do not possess any GST registration, an alternative plan/route for their registration is currently under process and is being explored. The same shall be communicated in due course, once finalised, and all stakeholders are requested to await further instructions in this regard before raising individual queries.**

8. All Associations/Corporations/EPCs are requested to bring the above to the notice of their member units and to encourage them to complete their login, profile update and registration formalities on the TSRS portal at the earliest.
9. This issues for information and necessary action, and for wide circulation among the units and stakeholders concerned.
